FOUNDATION FIGHTER SHRINGERI (21 YRS OLD)

Shringeri, a young energetic college student was preparing for her final semester B.Com examinations when she was diagnosed with a rare form of uterine cancer which needed urgent treatment. Shringeri's father had left them few years ago and her mother Lakshmi, took care of the family. Shringeri's dream was to finish her studies and get a job so she would be able to help support her family. Lakshmi managed to gather some money for the initial treatment from the little savings she had and by taking loans from relatives. But the need for two more chemotherapy sessions and 28 sittings of radiotherapy was financially out of her reach. HCG Foundation stepped in to aid Shringeri from the second cycle of chemotherapy onwards. Despite undergoing treatment, Shringeri studied and attended her examinations and cleared them. She has since completed her treatment and is ready to pursue her dreams. Her doctor is positive that she will do well and has not suggested any further treatment.





HEALTH CAMPAIGN AT SCHOOLS

Nutrition session was conducted by HCG Hospital's senior dietician, Sonali Datta at Mission School. 5th and 6th Std students got benefited with this program. The session discussed some of the problems unhealthy eating causes and how it continues well into adulthood. Unhealthy eating can even develop into lifelong diseases such as Cancer. The session was aimed to educate the students on healthy food habits. Sonali explained the benefits of eating vegetables and fruits as well as the detriment of junk foods with the help of fun filled activities with the students.

The interactive session gave insight about the on-going eating habits of children and unhealthy eating habits were rectified with nutritious healthy food habits.

Art therapy is an expressive language of the conscious and the unconscious minds. Thus, it makes us understand and assimilate things much more easily. Art Therapy is capable of promoting self-expression, feelings, and emotions. When someone comes to an art therapy session, they have the opportunity to use a range of art materials to explore & express feelings in a different yet effective way.



Art therapist Shah Sabreen, conducted a program on art therapy for the children at the hospital, with an aim to release all bottled up emotions, drive away negative emotions while absorbing positive energy. They did this by creating drawings or notes and then attaching the same to a balloon and setting it free.

The main goal was to make children express things that they cannot or will not always explain verbally. This kind of therapy opens up avenues of communication other than verbal, allowing one to express themselves without barriers. Art Therapy activity is one of many programs that helps people towards better health and happiness.
